Rock Daily finally has the scoop on the official 2008 Bonnaroo lineup: Pearl Jam, Metallica, Robert Plant & Alison Krauss, Kanye West and Jack Johnson lead the gigantic lineup for the seventh annual music fest. They'll be joined by the Raconteurs, My Morning Jacket, Death Cab for Cutie, Phil Lesh & Friends and many more. The event, held from June 12-15th in Manchester, Tennessee, will feature more than 100 bands spread across thirteen stages as well as a comedy tent headlined by David Cross and Janeane Garofalo. Still curious about those rumors Led Zeppelin will be playing the fest? Well, Bonnaroo is promising the next best thing (kind of): Lez Zeppelin, the all-girl Zep tribute band.
